

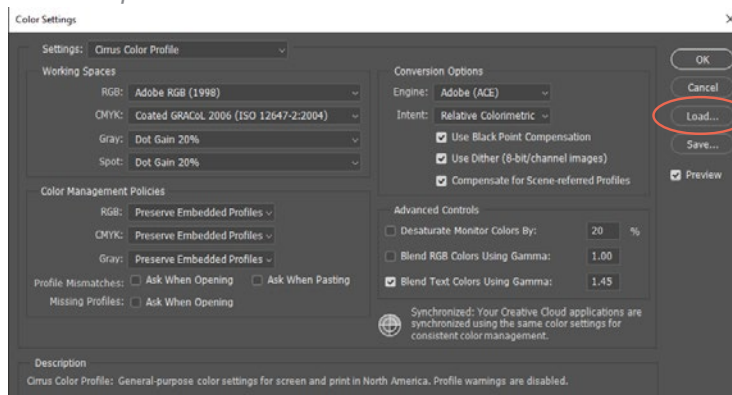
CIRRUS COLOR PROFILES

Installation Guide for Adobe Applications

This Color Profile is used to accurately match colors on the printers and common papers used at Cirrus Visual.

- Step 1) Extract the Cirrus Color Profile:
[Cirrus Color Profile.csf](#)
- Step 2) Copy the file into this folder found on your C drive:
[C:\Users\“YourUserNameHere”\AppData\Roaming\Adobe\Color\Settings](#)
- Step 3) Open Photoshop, then find “Color Settings” under “Edit” (Shift+Ctrl/Cmd+K):
[Click “LOAD” on the right column and navigate to the Cirrus Color Profile](#)

Photoshop:



- Step 4) Open Adobe Bridge, then find “Color Settings” under “Edit” (Shift+Ctrl/Cmd+K)
[Click “Show Saved Color Settings Files”](#)
[Navigate to the original location of the Color Profile as noted above](#)

- Step 5) Repeat process for Illustrator & Indesign

TIPS

- NEVER edit images in CMYK - retain an RGB color space
- Make sure Photoshop and Illustrator document color modes are set to “RGB” (under “File”, “Document Color Mode”)
- Click “Control/Command-Y” in Photoshop to see the CMYK translation of the file
- Always export PDFs with the PDFx4 preset
